 - Part A Written (10%)
 - Part B Multiple choice (10%)
- **Fixed dates**
- Grade 12 English, Social Studies, Math 30-1-2, Science, Chemistry, Biology and Physics
- Worth 20% of a final grade in a course
- Length varies, must stay for a minimum of one hour

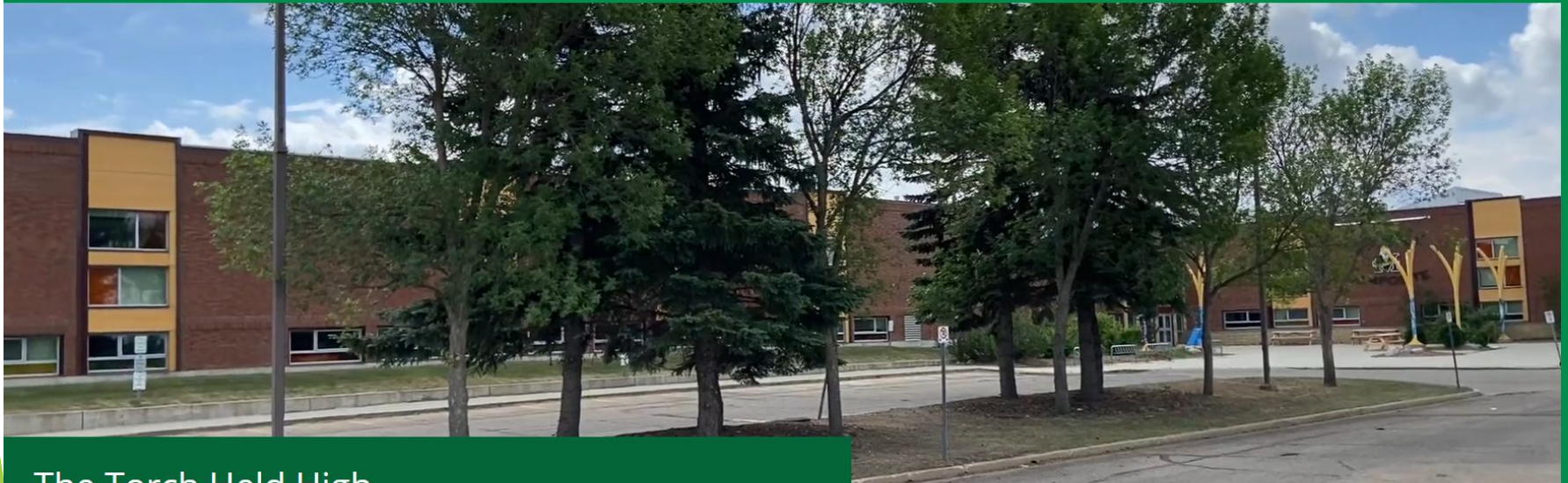

- ✓ Locally developed/acquired and locally authorized courses in CTS
- ✓ Registered Apprenticeship Program courses

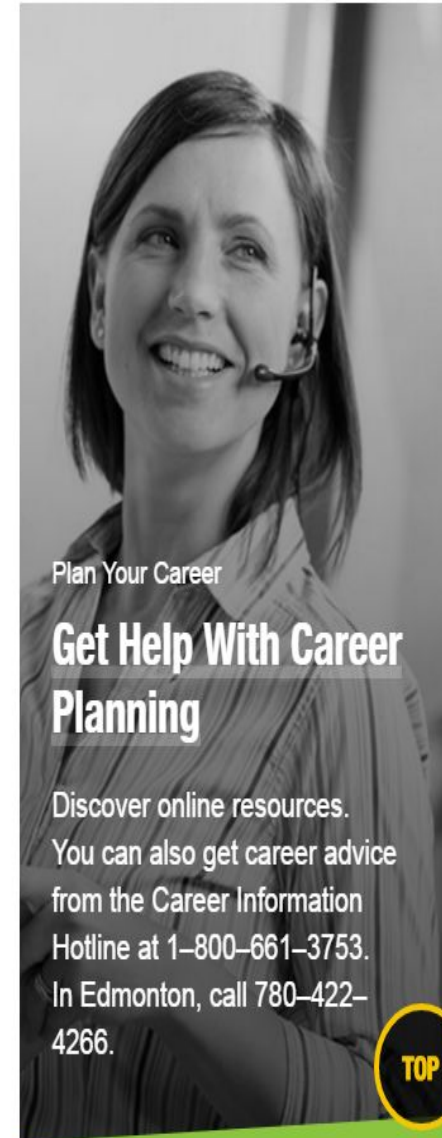

- ▶ Create a username & password, using MyAlberta Digital ID & ASN
- ▶ Grade 10 & 11 final grades & Grade 12 predicted final grades
- ▶ Each institution has a different application fee
- ▶ Can choose 2 programs / institution
