a. Staff - Mr. Stuckey

There will be games, contests, vendors, karaoke as well as other activities and of course, anime! Entry fee will be \$5.00 and will be open to all Parkland and select Evergreen Catholic schools.
- b. Slo-Pitch has started. Practices run this week, our first game is on May 3rd and is a home game. We would love spectators. Game starts at 4:15.
- c. Memorial has successfully nominated three students to participate in the three month Germany/Alberta exchange for 2023/2024. Memorial will have three German students in our school from Sept-Dec 2023, and our students will go there from Feb-May 2024.
- d. The badminton team starts playoffs tonight, and will be heading out to Beaumont. If we win tonight, we will be in the division finals on Wednesday.
- e. For POC Talks, we are hosting Culture Week from May 1-5, ending the week with the Pep Rally and Taste of Memorial.
- f. Spruce Grove Composite is hosting a "Life after High School" event specifically designed for Knowledge and Employability students on

Wednesday, May 24th, 6pm. They will have Olds College and Norquest College there to present on some transition programs, Gateway Association about supports, and Trade Secrets there to inform them of job prospects and requirements. The program will begin at 6:00 with 10 minute presentations from each organization. Then there will be an opportunity to visit their tables to ask questions. Light snacks and drinks will be provided. This will take place in SGCHS cafeteria and lounge area. MCHS will host the event next year.
