- i. PSD Modular Submission Request We anticipate that we will be at capacity next year and we have submitted a request for 8 modular units.
- ii. SGCHS Construction Funding Funding has been approved for the new building.
- iii. Shikaoi Visit and Future Planning Currently the Town of Stony Plain and the Town of Shikaoi have a relationship which involves a visit from a group of students from the Shikaoi High School. A discussion was held on whether or not it would be beneficial to have a more formal relationship between the two high schools. Mr. Haley will pursue this possibility.
- iv. Torch Time usage rates Currently, only 18.1% of students are utilitzing Torch Time. A discussion was held on how this could be improved. A parent survey will be conducted.
